




## Small Group/ Reflection Notes

How did they impact you? <input type="checkbox"/> If no one had said anything or modelled anything to you about Christian faith, would you still be involved/ believe today? <input type="checkbox"/> How is faith 'passed on'? <input type="checkbox"/> Who have you/ are you/ could you be passing faith on to? What been your experience? And others response? If you don't, who misses out?

What was this location for them? <input type="checkbox"/> <a href="#">v.19</a> : What did Jesus invite them to do? Why is a personal invitation so powerful? Why <i>follow</i> Jesus? What does that suggest Jesus is doing? Why is Christian discipleship <i>come + follow + go</i> ? <input type="checkbox"/> <a href="#">v.20</a> : How did they respond? Why? Why was this a 'no brainer' ('at once')? What was the cost to them? See <a href="#">John 1:35-42</a> : Who followed Jesus first? What did Andrew do? Why do we sometimes find it hardest to share our faith with family members or those we're closest to? What's your experience? <input type="checkbox"/> <a href="#">v.21-22</a> : Why 'go on' for others? Why is there never enough? How did their new-found faith affect their business/ career/ family?		
 Go further	<input type="checkbox"/> Read <a href="#">Matthew 28:16-20</a> <input type="checkbox"/> <a href="#">v.16-17</a> : Can <i>worship</i> and <i>doubt</i> co-exist? What happens when one tries to deny the other? When can focusing in on worship be as unhealthy as focusing in on doubt? <input type="checkbox"/> <a href="#">v.18-19</a> : What was Jesus' answer to worship and doubt? Was this a <i>particular</i> call for a particular people (The Eleven) or a general call for ALL Christ-followers? To what extent does it apply to you/ us? <input type="checkbox"/> <a href="#">v.20</a> : How and why is Jesus with us <i>when we go</i> ? What does this suggest Jesus is doing? Why is mission <i>with</i> Jesus? Who's mission is it? How can a passing reference in conversation about your faith, or a simple invitation to meet for coffee at the church café, be a first step in mission?		
 Reflect	<input type="checkbox"/> Which one verse stands out to you? Why do you think it grabs your attention? <input type="checkbox"/> Which verse(s) will you need to think more about? Why?		

 Do	<input type="checkbox"/> Go for a <i>walk</i> with Jesus and intentionally see people (don't get weird on them!) <input type="checkbox"/> Invite someone to come to church (to the Café, a Sunday service...)
 Pray	Say slowly and repeat multiple times: <i>Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and shall be forever. Amen. <b>Glory to the Father, and to the...</b></i>
