What was it designed to do? Why is it wrong to blame Judaism for the death of Jesus? How has the misuse of Matthew 27:25 fuelled antisemitism? Why & how, in the way we tell the 'Easter story', do we reject antisemitism? □ <u>v.3-5</u> Why might Jesus have given a 'no comment' interview? □ <u>v.6-8</u> How was this like a TV vote? 364 days a year Pilate was brutal. For 1 day only, for 1 person only, he wanted to appear generous/ kind. Why? How do you spot 'gesture politics'? □ <u>v.7</u> What did Barabbas and Jesus have in <i>common?</i> (See also Matthew 27:15-16) How were they <i>different</i> to each other? Bar-Abbas means 'son of [Bar] the father [Abbas]' Who was Jesus Christ THE Son of? How was it a choice between two Jesuses/ two kinds of revolution? How do some representations of Jesus today owe more to Barabbas? e.g. use of force, intimidation, power □ <u>v.11</u> How might the crowd have been manipulated? Why? When have you felt or witnessed manipulation? How do we guard against this? □ <u>v.13</u> How could the same 'crowd' shout 'Hosanna' [save us] Son of [Bar] David on 'Palm Sunday' and a few days later 'Crucify him'? Why are we the 'crowd'? □ <u>v.15</u> Why are we 'Barabbas'? How was Barabbas saved by Jesus? What do you imagine/hope Barabbas went on to do with his 'new life'? What about us? □ <u>Matthew 27:24</u> Why did Pilate wash his hands? Pilate knew Jesus was innocent and yet was still content to see Him crucified. When have we seen this? Who might think feel we have 'washed our hands of them'?		
Go further	□ Compare all 4 Gospel accounts: Matthew 27:11-26; Mark 15:1-15; Luke 23:1-25; John 18:28-19:1. What des each add?
