Why does Paul say this is what some are like with God?<br><input type="checkbox"/> Imagine the sun bouncing off a mirror, lighting you up. Your face then reflects the sun. Why does Paul say this is how we reflect God's mirror image? |                  |   |
| <br>Reflect       | <input type="checkbox"/> 2 Cor.3:12-18. Which verse stands out? Why does it grab your attention?<br><input type="checkbox"/> If not a sunny day, find a picture of sun. Spend time with it. What is the sun like? What is it doing to you: physically, emotionally, mentally, spiritually..?<br><i>[Don't stare at the sun]</i> Reflect: this is a picture of what God is like/ doing.                    |                  |   |

| <br>Pray          | Read Numbers 6:24-26 slowly/ repeatedly. Pray it over others. Then over you!<br><i>Dear God,</i><br><i>The LORD bless _____ [for others/ then for yourself] and keep YOU; the LORD make his face shine on YOU and be gracious to YOU; the LORD turn his face toward YOU and give YOU peace.
