


The Beatitudes!

in Spirit?



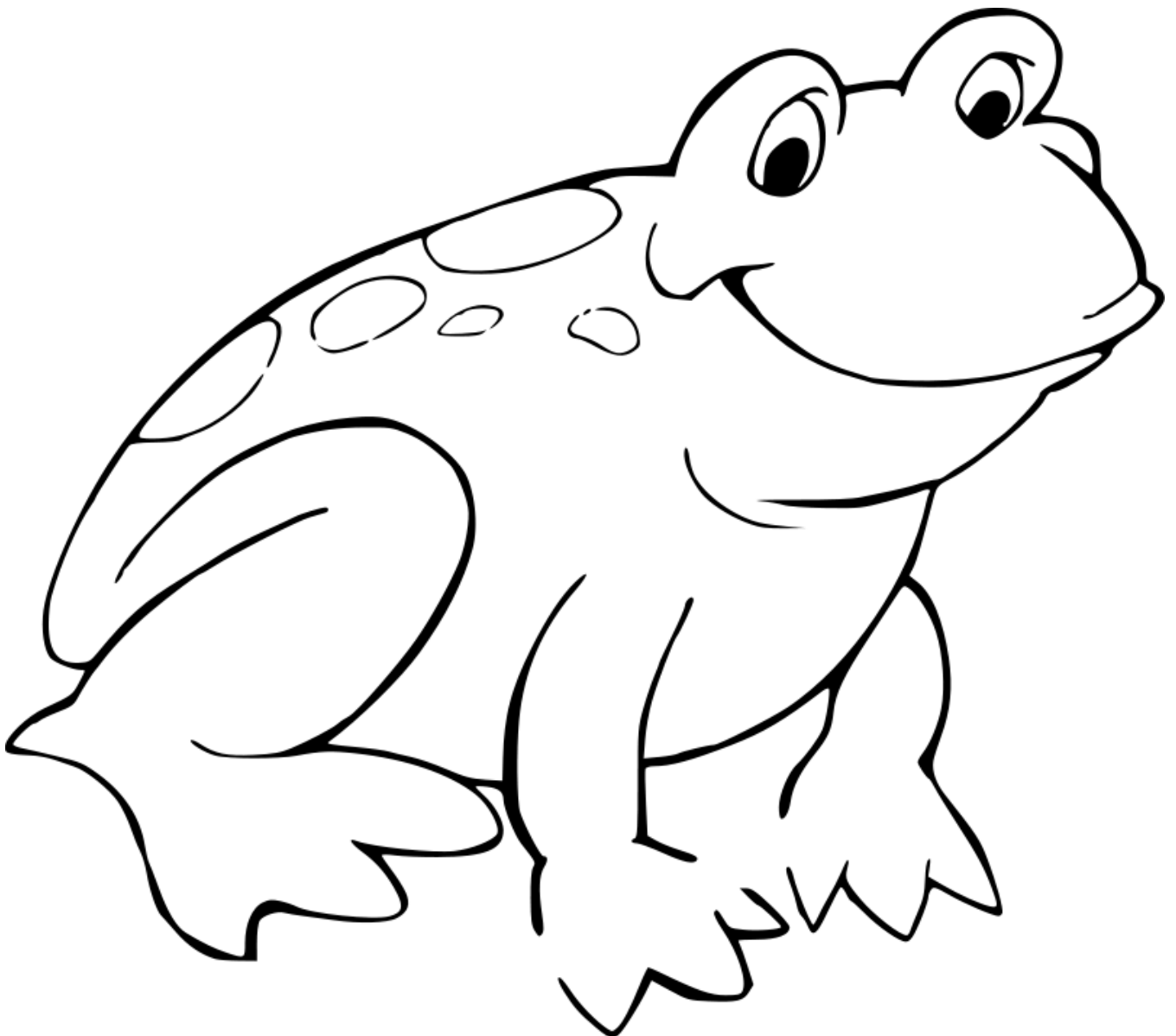
FROG craft

When we are poor in spirit, we learn to “Fully Rely On God” (FROG). Make a frog to remind you to trust in God for your needs.

Here’s an example of making one with paint.

- Make two hand prints on the paper using green paint. These will be the frog’s feet.
- Paint a large green circle for the frog’s body.
- Paint two white oval shaped eyes above the body.
- Use black paint to make a mouth, nostrils, and pupils.
- At the bottom, use a marker to write “Fully Rely On God.”

Or you can print this frog out and colour it in.
