


For this weeks resources we've attached some activity pages for you to have a go at!

Can you put them in the correct order? Number them 1–6.


Read this story again in John 6:5–15.

Jesus broke the bread before he gave it to the crowd.


Copy the picture of the basket of food into the empty box. Now finish it with felt-tips or crayons.

One of the disciples is giving the boy's food to Jesus. Finish the drawing with crayons or felt-tips.


Read this story in John 6:5–15.
