	07-02-2021		Ezekiel's prophetic call
Start Start	Play a game of Suddenly. The leader starts a story with a sentence that ends in SUDDENLY. The next person has to add to the story with their own sentence ending in SUDDENLY. Continue until everyone has contributed.		
Discuss	 Red = Stop. What does it mean to wait? How can this be a rich time? Amber = Get ready. What can you/ we do now to better prepare for 'GO!' Green = GO! What are you hoping for/ prophetically imagining could be? 		
Read	Ezekiel 2:1-3:15	J Listen again	ChesterRoadBaptist.org.uk/Watch ChesterRoadBaptist.org.uk/Talks
Discuss	 v.1: God calls Ezekiel. To what extent do <i>you</i> feel called by God? v.2: When have you felt God nudge you to do something? v.3-4: Why did the Israelites (God's people') need saving (again)? v.5-6: Why does it take courage to go against the flow, even in the church? v.7-8: How was Ezekiel to be different? v.9-10: Why must Ezekiel 'eat the scroll'? What does it mean to read/ study/ pray/ live/ depend on the Scriptures? See also Matthew 4:4 & John 6:32-35. v.2, 3:12 & 14: The Holy Spirit was active in Ezekiel's life. When do you feel the Holy Spirit active in your life? Why is being 'Word <u>and</u> Spirit' so powerful? 3:15: Why was Ezekiel deeply distressed? See also 2:10. Why does God lament/ grieve? What do you lament (grieve over)? 		
Go further	 v.1: If 'Son of Man' in Hebrew is 'ben adam' i.e. 'son of Adam – son of all mankind/ humanity', how is Ezekiel representative of us/ you? Why/how did Jesus the Son of Man become the ultimate representative of us? Which one verse stands out to you? Why do you think it grabs your attention? Which verse(s) will you need to think more about? Why? 		
Do	Bake a cake/ biscuits and ice on a word, phrase or Scripture verse. What might God be 'saying' to you? Like Ezekiel, eat it! Alternatively, do this as a prophetic baking gift for someone else.		
Pray	Dear God, Thank you for calling me to serve You. Help me to Give me the courage to Holy Spirit, show me what You lament/ grieve over. Amen.
