Start	□ Play a game of <i>Charades</i> . One person thinks of a book, film, song, or TV programme which they must then mime act for the others to guess. The 'actor' mustn't speak or use any words.		
Discuss	 □ What advert has managed to get your attention recently. How? Why do some adverts stand out but others don't? □ How do creative/ expressive/ performance arts 'move' us? What's their use/ potential in church? □ What is the role of a prophet? How should the gift of prophecy be used today?

Explore	 □ v.1: Why was now the time to cut through 'blah blah' with something different? □ v.3: How can creative/ expressive/ performance arts be prophetic/ a 'sign'? □ v.4: If this was Charades, how was Ezekiel acting out Jesus? □ v.5: To what extent have we as nations been drifting from God over the last 390 years? Why is Psalm 103:8 so reassuring? □ v.9: What was the physical/ mental/ spiritual cost to Ezekiel? And you? □ v.12: How bad would things have to get for you to use your excrement for fuel? □ v.14 Even in Babylon, Ezekiel kept his integrity. How do you try to do this? 		
Go further	 v.17: How/ why does 'sin' have consequences, even for our health/ well-being? Just because God says something will happen does not mean it has to happen. Why? Explain! Genesis 1-2 reveals God's creativity and power. Why do they so often go together? Why is it 'both/and', not 'either/or'? 		
Reflect	 □ Which one verse stands out to you? Why do you think it grabs your attention? □ Which verse(s) will you need to think more about? Why? □ Psalm 103:8. Meditate on <u>slow</u> and <u>quick</u>. 		
D 0	☐ Spend time studying a map of your area. What do you see? What words come to mind? Ask God what He is saying? Pray for your neighbours, those living and working in your community.		
Pray	Dear God, Thank you that You are slow to anger and quick to bless. Help me to be the same. Holy Spirit, release in me both Your creativity and power so that I might Amen.
