Start	Where is the furthest place you have ever travelled to?		
Discuss	 Why do you think there are four gospels? What makes each of these different eye-witness accounts distinct for you? 		
Read	<u>Mark 1:1-14</u>	June 2017	ChesterRoadBaptist.org.uk/Watch ChesterRoadBaptist.org.uk/Talks
P Explore	 What is a disciple? What is discipleship? What's the difference between being a <i>witness</i> and being a <i>disciple</i>? Mark's account stresses the journey motif of Jesus' life: firstly in and around Galilee as a place of receptivity, and then moving to Jerusalem: a place of opposition and suffering. How is this like the experience of being a disciple of Jesus? Can you give any specific, personal examples? Reading further on in the chapter v.16-18, Jesus calls fishermen to become fishers of men; what would this have meant for Simon and Andrew? Mark doesn't gloss over the disciples' failures: which can you spot in chapters 4:10-13, 35-41; 6:30-52, 9:14-41 and 10:13-16? Why do you think Mark includes these in his record? What do we learn about being a disciple from these examples? How did Jesus' disciples misunderstand Jesus' mission? How did they see it? How do you see it? Has it changed? What is the purpose of the church? How far do you agree with William Temple's view that "The Church is the only organisation that does not exist for itself, but for those who live outside of it." Remind yourself of the <u>Chester Road Baptist Church mission statement</u>. What are we doing to work towards this? What will <u>you</u> do? 		
Go further	 Read Mark 16:14-20. Why is this known as 'the great commission'? What impact did the disciples have in their mission? Is this commission still relevant for us today or was it only to the specific group then? Why do you think there has been a shift in #growingcommunity from the global North to the global South over the past 120 years? 		

Reflect	 Which one verse stands out to you? Why do you think it grabs your attention? Which verse(s) will you need to think more about? Why? What is God putting on <i>your</i> heart?
