Explore	 Ps.23:4 What does it mean to walk through Death Valley? As an individual? As a nation? Who else is with us? With life embracing increasing rapid change, how might the Queen have become a symbol of continuity and reassurance? Heb.13:8. How is humanity's search for continuity ultimately found in Jesus? Ps.46:1-2 When what seems familiar disappears, how does faith in God help? Rev.22:13 Why might this help us deal with change? Rev.19:16 What does this say about authority: the Queens? Jesus'? How is faith in Jesus the great leveller? By all accounts, the Queen had a genuine and personal faith in Jesus; not by her birth, but her choice (re-birth). What comfort does this bring?
