 Explore	<input type="checkbox"/> <u><a href="#">v.11</a></u> : What is <i>shame</i> ? What does it do? When have you observed or experienced shame? See <u><a href="#">Psalm 25:2</a></u> : to what extent is this the prayer of <i>everyone</i> today, religious or not? See <u><a href="#">Romans 3:23</a></u> : if <u><a href="#">all</a></u> (everyone) have sinned, why does shame single out us/ others out as 'worse than others'? See <u><a href="#">Hebrews 12:2</a></u> : how does Christ deal with our shame? How is this good news for all today? <input type="checkbox"/> <u><a href="#">v.12-13</a></u> : how does shame affect those in the Church? Outside the Church? See <u><a href="#">Romans 10:9</a></u> : what's the difference between <i>passive</i> acknowledgement of God and <i>active</i> faith in who Jesus was/is? Why is it both/and? What does it mean to <i>call on the name of the Lord</i> ? <input type="checkbox"/> <u><a href="#">v.14</a></u> : To what extent do people today know the essence of Christianity? How has this happened? What would turn this around? Whose responsibility is this? How do/ could we tell our story to those we're connected to? What's been your experience of this? <input type="checkbox"/> <u><a href="#">v.15</a></u> : Do you/we need to feel <i>called</i> to tell others about Christ? To what extent do you feel compelled to tell others? Why are feet that bring good news beautiful?		
 Go further	<input type="checkbox"/> What is Jesus ' <i>good news</i> '? Why sometimes does our telling of the 'good news' sound to others more like 'bad news'? How do we tell the 'good news' about Jesus in a way that people today perceive to be 'good news'? How do we be 'good news' people?
