Explore	 v.1-3: What is a natural spring? Describe it. Why does Paul describe generosity as flowing/ welling up, as from a <i>spring</i>? Where does generosity come from? Why might generosity be our 'natural state'? How does the 'spirit of this age' distort this? How does <i>grace</i> help restore our 'factory settings' to <i>generous</i>? To what extent is generosity linked to wealth? v.4-5: Why did being hard-pressed and hard-up not stop them giving? What is fundraising? If the <i>cause</i> is good (famine relief, cancer cure, world mission) does it matter how <i>funds</i> are raised and from whom? How is <i>giving</i> different to fundraising? v.6-7: If Corinth was known for its wealth, why might it be taking them longer to discover their inner generosity? Why people sometimes get funny when we talk about money? Why is giving both a spiritual discipline and a spiritual gift? What does it mean to <i>excel</i> at the grace of giving? Who's praying for the gift of giving? v.10-12: What's the difference between a demand and a gift? How does Paul keep the focus on giving? See John 3:16-17: How does God practice giving? Why? How does our giving the Corinthian Church to do? Why? What is 'planned giving'? Why give in proportion to our means/ income? Why does the sum change from year to year? What is responsible giving?
