Discuss	<ul> <li>□ "If you find a perfect church, don't join it – you'll spoil it!"</li> <li>□ What are you like with awkward 1:1 conversations?</li> <li>□ If you know you must have a potentially awkward/ difficult conversation with someone, do you get it over with ASAP or put it off for as long as possible?</li> </ul>

When this happens, what does Jesus tell us to do? Why not wait for the other person to come to their senses and approach you? Why is talking about (instead of to) someone tempting but counter-productive (even for prayer!)? Why do this 1:1, directly/ privately? If we feel frustrated/ hurt, but don't follow Jesus' advice, what are we communicating about them/ ourselves/ our relationship?    Have you ever been hurt/ offended by someone in church? Without mentioning names, what happened?   Have you ever been the one who offended/ upset someone else in the church? Again, without mentioning names, what happened? Read Matthew 5:23-24.   What are your tips for having such awkward conversations? When it goes well, why does it feel like a 'win'?   How does our "stuff" (situations, challenges, past experiences, personality characteristics) and/or their "stuff" affect our social dynamics?   v.16: If you've tried unsuccessfully to resolve the matter on your own, what does Jesus then tell us to do? Why? What does requiring the support of 1 or 2 others suggest about the unresolved issue? Have you experience of this? No names: what happened?   v.17: If even that hasn't worked, why not simply give up on them? What are good reasons/ motivations for involving the church community? And bad reasons/ motivations for involving the church community? What is the body of Christ called to model?   If you've tried everything and nothing has worked (they're still behaving like someone outside of faith/ church), what does Jesus tell us to do? Why is this still about not giving up on them; love, not judgment? How did Jesus famously treat tax collectors? Read Matthew 9:9-13. So, what does treating them like a 'tax collector look like?
