Discuss	 □ What are some of the big questions (objections) some people have about God? □ Is there such thing as <i>God</i>? □ Are there lots of gods? If so, which one? □ If there is God, why is there so much suffering/ chaos in the world? □ Mm □ How do you respond to them?

Explore	□ v.2: Why does God self-identify as, 'I AM'? See Exodus 3:1-5, esp. v.13-14. Why are our comparisons/ analogies/ descriptions/ explanations/ memes about God always inadequate/ incomplete? What part do questions, mystery, uncertainty, even doubt, play in your/ our grasp of God? How do all these help us grow in faith & understanding? Why is God always more [insert]? □ v.2: What did 'Egypt' represent for the Hebrews? [slavery, oppression, suffering, pain, grief] Where was God? How did God respond to their cries? Where were the Hebrews at this point? Have you ever felt 'in between', in the wilderness, drifting, maybe 'out of Egypt' but not yet 'in the Promised Land'? □ v.3: Why (then & now) are there so many different ideas about/ version of 'gods'? Why was Moses and Deut.6:4 so radical? There is simply God - One Creator God. Why is 'my god is better than your god' so unhelpful and misses the point? Why is God most perfectly seen/ understood in Jesus? □ v.3: If thought of as a commandment, what does v.3 traditionally sound like/ imply? What difference does receiving it as a promise make? e.g. You shall not have/ need for 'other gods' because I AM all you need, I AM the/ your One Creator God, with you in good and bad times.
