And especially, other people's "stuff"? □ What does advertising seek to do? How does it do this? □ Do digital/ contactless payments make it easier or harder to appreciate 'the value of money'? □ How do we avoid "stuff" becoming a substitute for God in our lives (idolatry)? □ How do we cultivate an attitude of gratitude? □ What does it mean to live more simply? Why bother? □ What came first: the <i>chicken</i> or the <i>egg</i>?

Explore	 □ v.17: What does it mean to 'covet' something or someone? How is this old-fashioned word apt for a totally modern attitude? Why do we 'covet'? Why do you think coveting is in 'the 10'? □ v.17: What examples of coveting were given? What does this say about Israelite society attitudes back then? Why were women and slaves viewed as "stuff" (objects/ possessions) alongside other 'belongings'? What is dehumanising language? What can it lead to? How does coveting dehumanise others? Dehumanise us? □ v.17: How can 'coveting' as an attitude, if left unchecked, result in actions that break the other #1st-9th? □ Philippians 4:11-13: What does it mean to 'be content'? Is it easier to be content when you have plenty or are in need? How do you 'learn the secret to contentment'? How does cultivating an attitude of gratitude help foster contentment? □ 1 Peter 2:9: How/ why are we/you God's 'possession'? How does this bolster our selfworth? Why is "stuff" no substitute for knowing who we truly are in Christ? Is this just a Christian cliché? □ What comes first: our love for God or our desire to keep 'the 10'? □ What turns this #10th from a commandment into a promise? 		
Go further	 Mark 12:28-34: Was Jesus referring specifically to 'the 10' or all of the Old Testament Law (Jewish tradition says, in all, there are 613 commandments.) How did Jesus summarise the Law? Love Love Why is love fundamentally core to the Law, including 'the 10'? What do each of 'the 10' look like through the lens of love?
