Start	□ What has your week been like?		
Discuss	<ul> <li>How does 1, 1, 1 = 1?</li> <li>What is the Trinity?</li> <li>How do you explain that Christins believe there is only one God, and yet worship <i>God</i> the Father, <i>God</i> the Son, and <i>God</i> the Holy Spirit?</li> <li>How do you explain the Trinity?</li> <li>What difference does the Trinity make to your Christian life?</li> </ul>

Explore	<ul> <li>God is One</li> <li>Genesis 1:1: What are the first four words of the Bible? What do they tell us about God? How/ why do they set the tone for the 727,965 words that follow?</li> <li>Why was (still is) <u>Deuteronomy 6:4</u> so radical? What does it mean for God to be <u>the</u> Lord? What does it mean for God to be <u>your</u> Lord? What do we mean when we say we feel at <u>one</u> e.g. with ourself; with our surroundings? How/ why is God at <u>one</u>? If God was just one god among many, what would that mean for God? And for us? If God is all-knowing (omniscient), all-powerful (omnipotent), in all-places (omnipresent), and all-loving (omnibenevolent), why can there only ever be one God? How/ why is One God all we could ever need?</li> <li>What difference does believing in One God/ God is One make to Christian living? To your life?</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>God is Trinity</li> <li>Matthew 3:16-17: Where is 'Trinity' mentioned? And yet, how does this scene reveal God as Trinity? What does this scene portray the interactions/ relationship between the persons of the Trinity? Why do we baptise in the name of the Trinity?</li> <li>Matthew 28:18-20: Where is 'Trinity' mentioned? And yet, how do these verses lead Christians to understand God as being Trinity? How/ why do these verses imply Trinity God is part of our normal Christian experience?</li> <li>2 Corinthians 13:14: Why link grace to Jesus? Why link <i>love</i> to the Father? Why link <i>fellowship</i> to the Holy Spirit? Is each attribute limited to one specific member of the Trinity or are they shared equally?</li> </ul>
