If God was just one god among many, what would that mean for God? And for us? If God is all-knowing (omniscient), all-powerful (omnipotent), in all-places (omnipresent), and all-loving (omnibenevolent), why can there only ever be one God?  Pray	Say this slowly and repeatedly: <i>Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for evermore. Amen.</i>
